Methodology

The Forum Poll™ was conducted by Forum Research with the results based on an interactive voice response telephone survey of 209 randomly selected Kenora-Rainy River residents 18 years of age and older. The poll was conducted on May 26th, 2014.

Results based on the total sample shown above are considered accurate +/- 7%, 19 times out of 20. Subsample results will be less accurate. Subsample results will be less accurate. Margins of error for subsample (such as age, gender) results are available at www.forumresearch.com/samplestim.asp

Where appropriate, the data has been statistically weighted by age, region, and other variables to ensure that the sample reflects the actual population according to the latest Census data.

This research is not necessarily predictive of future outcomes, but rather, captures opinion at one point in time. Actual results will depend on the parties' success at getting their voters out. Forum Research conducted this poll as a public service and to demonstrate our survey research capabilities.
